BOOKLETS TO ZIMBABWE.

This month I received an encouraging email from a preacher in Zimbabwe who has been receiving my Bound Lesson Booklets each month for about two years.

EASTSIDE MEMBER'S INITIATIVE.

Brett Anderson is an Eastside member who operates his own flooring business (carpet laying, floor tiles, wooden flooring etc) and about a year ago a flooring company in North East Tasmania called on Brett to assist this company's carpet layers to complete a larger than usual job.

Brett became friends with one of this company's employees, which led to religious discussions, resulting in this man phoning Brett regularly in the past year to ask Bible questions.

This month in my Sunday morning Bible Class I began teaching a new 13 lesson series entitled, "*A* handy guide to the Bible". I stressed to the members that before they question why I am teaching such an elementary series at Eastside, my motive for doing so is so that the Eastside members would know that I have a series of Bound Lesson Booklets available for them to hand out to relatives, friends, and contacts who have little or no knowledge of the Bible.

After me teaching Lesson one, Brett decided this series would be perfect for his new "friend" in North East Tasmania. Brett asked me for the thirteen bound lessons, and he drove for about an hour to deliver them to this man.

Last Sunday at Eastside's worship Brett told me this man phoned him this past week to tell Brett how wonderful he thinks these lessons are. He wanted to discuss aspects of lesson two with Brett and Brett had to tell him that I had only just completed teaching lesson one.

Because I only hand out the Bound Lesson Booklets to Eastside members after I have taught each lesson , Brett and this man have an arrangement that when I finish teaching each lesson in this series , Brett

will phone this man and tell him he also has his own bound copy and is ready to deal with this man's questions re the lesson I have just finished teaching.

HOBART VISITORS .

Last Sunday a man, his wife, and their teenage son, who are originally from Brazil but are now living in Tasmania's Capital city (Hobart) attended Eastside's Bible Class and worship service. They have been members of the Mornington Hill church of Christ in Hobart for about a year, but had never visited any other church in Tasmania in the time they have been in Hobart.

They drove the three hours to Launceston to visit our Eastside member from Brazil (Renee Alves), thus Renee brought them to Eastside.

After our worship had finished this husband and wife said they really want to return to Launceston and spend more time with us. Of course we offered them free accommodation in our "brethren's apartment".

At our Bible Class last night Renee told us that before this family returned to Hobart they told her they were "blown away" by the warm welcome they received from all the Eastside members, and were already planning when they could visit us again.

HILLWOOD ACTIVITY BEGINS .

This month the Australian Rules Football season began, meaning that every second Saturday Jackie and I leave home at 7 am and drive twenty minutes to a country area of Tasmania called Hillwood, with its football club.

From 7.30 am until 9 am Jackie makes 80 salad rolls and I fill 50 plus bags of mixed sweets. At 9 am Jackie works until 2 pm in the club's food outlet, and I alternate between working in this Canteen and fulfilling duties as the club's "Chaplain" (without the title).

Our involvement with this football club has afforded us many opportunities to talk to people about the gospel. I have conducted four wedding ceremonies of members of this club, which gave me opportunity to teach the Bible to groups of people that I would have otherwise never met - 1 Cor 9: 19 - 22.

Every Saturday someone will engage me in religious discussion.

LESSONS TAUGHT BY ME AT EASTSIDE IN APRIL.

Most of my Bible class and sermon subjects take several weeks to cover due to the nature of the Eastside members who need constant repetition, detailed explanations, and mutual discussions among brethren re personal applications of Biblical principles in their lives.

Also, I encourage members to ask questions re anything they do not understand or even something that is a side issue to what we are actually studying at the time Thus it is very rare for me to ever complete a lesson in one Bible class.

Study periods : Preparing sermons and Bible classes for Eastside's meetings.

Lesson booklets : Ongoing typing, photocopying, stapling, and binding of new and replacement booklets for requests, and for display at our church meetings.

Study packs : Ongoing photocopying, stapling, and packaging of these as time permits.

Letterboxing : Jackie and I make every effort to continue this project on a weekly basis, but often a lack of time does not allow this to happen.
